About the Exhibit

Our desire is to represent the creativity of God through the personal expression of local artists. We encourage thought provoking, “out of the box,” but appropriate, art. Our theme for this year is *Redemption*. Entries can, but need not, contain “traditional” redemption type content. The exhibit will be viewed throughout the week of March 29 through April 2, with varying hours. The hours are Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 12:00–4:00 PM, and Wednesday from 12:00–6:00PM. Friday’s exhibit hours are from 1:00–9:00 with an artists’ reception from 3:00-6:00 PM and a Good Friday Service from 7:00–8:00.

About the Jury

As an event sponsored by Creekside Community Church, the jury will be comprised of the church leadership team to determine the appropriateness of content. While creativity is celebrated, caution needs to be taken with regard to honoring the Lord.

Award Best Representation of Theme

The theme for the 2010 Passion Week Art Exhibit is “Redemption”. The “Best Representation of Theme” will be awarded at the conclusion of the exhibit based on viewer response. Along with a certificate of achievement, the artist whose work receives this distinction will be invited to display their piece, along with additional works, at the ministry center through the end of McMinnville’s monthly Art & Wine Walk, April 17th.

Submission Details

The Passion Art Exhibit: Redemption is open to all artists, limit one entry per person. Works may be of any medium; limited to 20”x30”. Entries must be properly mounted for display. All 2-D works should be wired for hanging. Each work must be delivered at the artist’s expense. Artwork is to be brought to the Creekside Community Church ministry center at the address listed above.

Artwork must be received between the hours of 11:30 and 4:00 March 16-19. All artwork will be reviewed by jury during the week of March 22nd. All submissions are to remain on display until made available for pick-up on Saturday, April 3rd. Artwork can be picked up at the completion of the event on Saturday, April 3rd between 10:00 and 2:00 PM, or between 11:30 am and 4:00 PM April 6-9. If awarded “Best Representation of Theme,” it is agreed upon that the winning entry will remain in possession of Creekside Community Church until pick-up anytime between the hours of 11:30 am and 4:00 pm April 20-23 (unless other arrangements are mutually agreed upon).

Insurance, Liability and Sales

All works included in the exhibition will be insured at the discretion and expense of the artist while they are in Creekside Community Church’s possession, from the time of delivery until reclaimed by the artist. Creekside Community Church will not be held responsible for any artwork entered into this exhibit for any reason including, but not limited to, damage, theft or loss. As of 4:00 PM April 9th, 2010 unclaimed artwork will be forfeited. Works may be made available for sale with the artist’s permission as indicated on the entry form below. Potential purchasers will be given the artist’s contact information. It is the responsibility of the artist to make arrangements with the purchaser for delivery of sold art after the event has ended and the artist has picked up the work.

AGREEMENT

Submitting an entry form to this exhibition constitutes an agreement on the part of the artist with all conditions in this prospectus. Entry in the exhibit gives permission for an artwork to be photographed and used for publicity purposes. Creekside Community Church reserves the right not to exhibit a work if it does not meet the expectations of the jury.
